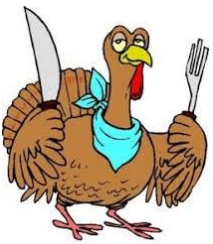

Bad Weather, School Delays or Closures

As the weather turns colder, there is a possibility that we could experience delayed starts and even school closures; it is rare, but it happens. You will be notified via our Auto Dialer system as soon as the decision has been made. You can also get this information by tuning in to the local radio and TV stations. Media obtains and broadcast their information from Flash News, www.flashnews.net. You may also go to their site for information regarding our district's operations or our district website, www.pleasanthill.k12.or.us, if accessible during weather related emergencies.

If we do have a delayed start, buses still run; just 2 hours later than usual. So, if your child is picked up at 7:15 in the morning they will be picked up at 9:15 instead. School will start at 10:00 and lunches are served on their normal schedule. We dismiss as usual at 2:15 p.m.

Bus Snow Routes for Weather/Emergency

When road conditions are such that the district transportation system will be restricted the following changes in bus routes will take place. If there are no announcements transportation will operate as usual.



Hills Creek Road - Route C

The bus will turn around travel at Weyerhaeuser Road just beyond 37937 Hills Creek Road; students living beyond this stop may catch the bus here too.

Lost Creek Road - Route K

The bus will turn around at Guilley Creek Road, above the Old Gustina Mill Road before RR Anderson; students living beyond this stop may catch the bus here too.

Lost Valley Lane - Route H

This road will be BYPASSED. Students may catch the bus at either end of Lost Valley Lane; those students getting on the bus at Lost Creek will be on Route K.

Rattlesnake Road - Route H

The Rattlesnake Road Hill will be BYPASSED; students can catch the bus at Kimball Road or at Lost Valley Lane.

North Morningstar -Route F

This road will be BYPASSED. The bus will pick up students at the intersection of North Morningstar Road and Enterprise Road

Wallace Creek Road - Route D

The bus will turn around at Weyerhaeuser Road, just beyond 37047 Wallace Creek Road; students living above this road will be able to catch the bus there.



State Report Card

Each year the Oregon Department of Education prepares a report card for each school and district

as required by law (ORS 329.115), requiring schools to notify families these are available for their viewing, as well. The purpose of the report card is to share a glance as to how the school district and schools are progressing towards meeting educational goals and other information such as student attendance, teacher experience and opportunities for extracurricular and intervention supports for students both in and out of school.

To view report cards online, head to the ODE <http://www.ode.state.or.us/data/reportcard/reports.aspx>, and enter Pleasant Hill School District and a list of available report cards will be generated. Select the one you are interested in reviewing. Hard copies of our school and district report card are also available in our foyer on the information table.

As you review this information, please note that the report cards have undergone significant redesign from prior years. This year no schools in the state received an overall rating as in years past. The data gleaned from the state report cards are used to measure ongoing student achievement in addition to local curriculum-based measures to provide the appropriate support, interventions and enrichment activities to best meet the needs of our students.



Volunteers

We thank all our volunteers for their participation and dedication to the students of Pleasant Hill Elementary. There are many ways for parents/guardians to volunteer such as assisting with PTO events and activities such as room parent, helping students in the classroom, chaperoning field trips, copying and preparing materials, field day, etc.

Pleasant Hill School District policy requires all volunteers to have completed a criminal background check. Therefore, if you would like to volunteer we ask you to simply fill out the criminal background check form available in the office or on-line at www.pleasanthill.k12.or.us and turn into school office.

If you are not sure that you have completed the volunteer background check process, the office has a list of approved volunteers. Please also understand it can take up to three to four weeks for the Oregon Department of Education to complete the background check process including notifying the school district you are approved to volunteer. Therefore, if you want to volunteer at some point in the school year, even if it is to go on a field trip, we also ask that you fill out a criminal background check as soon as possible.
