If test results show elevated levels, actions will be taken to stop access and correct the problem. Corrective actions may include covering water fountains and providing bottled water, shutting off water sources, replacing fixtures and lines, etc. Elevated testing locations will be retested after corrective actions have been completed. Upon retest, if levels are still elevated additional corrective action will occur. Test results will be made public and posted to the district website www.pleasanthill.k12.or.us.

5. Lead Paint

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule, the district will contract with certified contractors and/or district staff certified by the Oregon Health Authority will perform the work.

6. Integrated Pest Management

7. Communication

The district will make all test results and detailed information explaining the test results available to the public within five business days of receiving the results.
