#### **Supply Chain Impacts on School Menus**

At Pleasant Hill School District, we know the importance of school meals in fueling both healthy minds and bodies. Even though school meals may look a little different during School Year 2021-2022, please know that your school nutrition team is working hard to ensure students have safe, nutritious, and appealing meals. Today, I am writing to share how our district is working to overcome food supply and labor challenges related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) public health emergency so that students continue to receive school meals.

At times, our school district may not receive expected food orders due to labor shortages (such as delivery drivers) and limited product availability (for example, discontinued products or not enough of a specific type of product). As a result, our kitchen may need to make last-minute changes to the menu or substitute a different brand of a food product. We know that students have favorite menu items and are working hard to provide them whenever possible. We are also thinking ahead to identify alternative food items that are nutritious and appealing for the students.

If your student has food allergies or a special dietary need, be assured that meeting these needs and keeping your student safe remains a priority for us, and we will continue to provide meal modifications.

We appreciate your patience, flexibility, and understanding as we work to provide school meals in a challenging and changing environment.

# Pending Expiration and Verification Letters

If you receive a pending eligibility expiration letter either via email or in the mail, your students will continue to receive free meals for this school year. However, if you do not complete a new 2021-22 Free/Reduced Meal application then you may lose P-EBT and other benefits, like free/reduced sports fees.

Verification Notices will be sent out this week randomly to approved free and reduced meal application families as required by Federal regulations at 7 CFR 245.6a. If your family receives a verification letter, please provide the requested documentation by November 1, 2021.

#### Parent Drop-off/Pick-up

<u>Drop-Off Times</u>: 7:45 - 8:00am - Students should arrive <u>no earlier than 7:45am</u> unless previous arrangements have been made

<u>Pick up Times</u>: 2:15p Mon-Thurs; 1:25p Fri. **Locations**:

- K /1 students in the front of the school
- > 2 / 3 students in front of the library
- 4 /5 students in front of the community center

\*Drop off/pick-up all students in the location of the youngest student in your household.

- Stop long enough to drop students off along the curb and move on.
- Do not double park...this causes traffic jams and requires students to walk through the parking lot to get to the curb.
- When parking, please walk your students to or from the sidewalk.
- DRIVE SLOWLY through the parking lot...watch for students and families who are walking in the parking lot.
- Students report directly to their classrooms at 7:45 a.m.
- Notify your child's teacher & the office with changes in your child's drop off or pick up routine <u>prior to 1:30 pm</u>

#### First Student Bus Rules

- > Have <u>face covering on before the bus pulls up</u> arrives. Keep your face covering on while on the bus.
- Please immediately go to your seat, and remain seated until you get to school/home.
- No playing, touching, or moving around to sit with other students on the bus
- > The driver will let you know when you can stand up to exit the bus.

Buses are cleaned after each route. All seats and high touched areas are cleaned with a disinfectant.
