STRATEGIC PLANNING WITH THE PHSD SCHOOL BOARD

The PHSD School Board Members will develop a strategic plan for our school district. This rigorous and inclusive strategic planning process will not only allow a team to create the needed information to guide the district but will also create shared ownership of the board's guiding documents and the district's strategic plan.

The PHSD Board, Superintendent, PHIP staff and community all have important roles to play in the strategic planning process. The Board is responsible for setting the strategic direction and priorities for the district and will have oversight of the strategies the district will use to reach goals. The Superintendent and PHIP staff operationalize the education vision of the Board and community. They help the Board set district goals and develop the strategies and detailed actions that will move the district forward, reporting on key tracking metrics. The community grounds the process by providing input at key points.

The starting points will be viewing and/or developing:

The Board's **Vision, Mission, and Values** explain where the district is going with student outcomes and **why**.

The **District Goals** set out **what** specific outcomes the district will accomplish.

The **District Strategic Plan** lays out **how** to achieve the district goals with key strategies and actions.

The **District Monitoring Plan** helps staff, the Board, and community to track progress.

PHSD has reached out to two vendors/facilitators for the Strategic Planning process. The first presentation was on Monday, June 6; it can be viewed online [here](#). The second presentation from Jerry Colonna will be held on June 20 at 6pm. Both of these presentations are on School Board meeting nights so if you would like to attend in person, please do so. A link to the second presentation will be made available as well.

Once the second presentation has been completed the board will choose which of these vendors/facilitators they would like to continue with through this process.
