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#### **Covid-19 Vaccination Clinic**

PHSD will be providing a host site for a Covid-19 vaccination clinic at the High School Student Center again. This clinic will be on Friday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 from 4-6pm.

This clinic will be providing 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> doses of the Pfizer vaccine as well as the J&J single dose vaccine.

It is important to remember, students ages 12-14 who are unaccompanied by parents/guardians must have a signed copy of <u>this Consent for Minor</u> <u>Vaccination Form</u> (Spanish) and this form must be presented at the time of vaccination.

Appointments for this clinic are available on a first-come-first-serve basis and can be scheduled <u>here.</u>

This event is planned and provided by OHA and Lane County Health. **All OHA** guidelines must be followed.

#### Proof of Vaccination/Exception

Per <u>OAR 333-019-1030</u>, Covid-19 Vaccination Requirements for Teachers and School Staff, all individuals who will be in direct contact with students must be **fully vaccinated** by **October 18<sup>th</sup>**, **2021**.

This rule applies to teachers, administrative staff, educational assistants, coaches, substitute teachers, drivers and volunteers. It applies to before/after school programs located at a school.

Documentation may include, but is not limited to, a Covid-19 vaccination record card or a copy/digital picture of the card, or a print-out from the Oregon Health Authority's Immunization Registry.

## **Proof of Vaccine**

An individual who has proof of vaccination or is seeking an exception needs to submit a vaccination card copy or assigned OHA exception form to Courtney Wilson, the assistant to the Superintendent, at cwilson@pleasanthill.k12.or.us, or in person at the district office. This information will be kept in a confidential health file here at the district office.

If an employee is under an exception under OAR 333-019-1030 **COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements for Teachers and School Staff** – (5) schools that grant an exception to the vaccination requirement under section (4) of this rule must take **reasonable steps** to ensure that unvaccinated teachers, school staff, and volunteers are protected from contracting and spreading COVID-19.

The reasonable steps have been approved by LPHA:

- 1) Individual must mask upon entry of district facilities
- 2) Sign in on the "Reasonable Steps Health Log
- 3) Check in with administrator or designee
- 4) Temperature check- individual temperature is to be no higher than 99.9 degrees F
- 5) Individual must answer NO to the following questions
  - Have you had a fever within the last 48 hours?
  - Do you have a cough?
  - Do you have a sore throat?
  - Are you having shortness of breath?
  - Have you been in close contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the last 72 hours?

## PHSD Assurances

PHSD is following the same process we utilized last year into this school year. We will continue to contact Lane Public Health Authority when we are notified of a potential positive case or a close contact of Covid-19, in order to ensure that we are following the health department's guidelines. The following documents, were submitted to ODE/OHA/LPHA before we opened for the school year:

<u>Safe to Return to School</u> • <u>Communicable Disease Management Plan</u> • <u>Covid-19 Exclusion Chart</u> • <u>When should I keep my child home</u>

#### Parent Drop-off/Pick-up

**Drop-Off Times**: 7:45 - 8:00am - Students should arrive <u>no earlier than 7:45am</u> unless previous arrangements have been made

Pick up Times: 2:15p Mon-Thurs; 1:25p Fri. Locations:

- > K /1 students in the front of the school
- > 2 / 3 students in front of the library
- 4 /5 students in front of the community center

\*Drop off/pick-up all students in the location of the youngest student in your household.

- Stop long enough to drop students off along the curb and move on.
- Do not double park...this causes traffic jams and requires students to walk through the parking lot to get to the curb.
- When parking, please walk your students to or from the sidewalk.
- **DRIVE SLOWLY** through the parking lot...watch for students and families who are walking in the parking lot.
- Students report directly to their classrooms at 7:45 a.m.
- Notify your child's teacher & the office with changes in your child's drop off or pick up routine prior to 1:30 pm

### First Student Bus Rules

- Have face covering on before the bus pulls up arrives. Keep your face covering on while on the bus.
- Please immediately go to your seat, and remain seated until you get to school/home.
- No playing, touching, or moving around to sit with other students on the bus
- The driver will let you know when you can stand up to exit the bus.

Buses are cleaned after each route. All seats and high touched areas are cleaned with a disinfectant.
