# Oregon Department of Education Director Colt Gill issued the following statement after new guidance from CDC was released on May 13th.



Today the <u>CDC released new guidance</u> related to fully vaccinated individuals and the use of face coverings and physical distancing.

This afternoon <u>Governor Brown issued a video statement</u> on how this new guidance will be implemented in Oregon. In her statement she shared, "Nothing is changing for schools this school year, and I expect education staff and students to continue to wear masks and physically distance, as outlined in our Ready Schools, Safe Learners guidance." This also applies to all other individuals on school campus, including but not limited to: family members, volunteers, visitors, SROs, and other partners.

ODE is currently working with OHA on guidance for next school year. We will begin to share a discussion draft including key changes for your input the week of May 24th. We will also notify you of any updates to RSSL guidance for summer school in the coming weeks.

Oregon's <u>Graduation Ceremony Guidance</u> aligns to the OHA's guidance for <u>indoor</u> and <u>outdoor</u> entertainment establishments. Please refer to that guidance and other guidance from OHA for any changes in the coming days that may reflect the Governor's announcement today.



## Contact your school with questions.

As per the Oregon Department of Education (ODE), our teachers will be administering required state tests to grades 3-8 and 11 before this school year is over. This year the state testing will occur on May 27<sup>th</sup> for grades 3-8, and on June 8<sup>th</sup> for grade 11.

Remote testing is not permitted by ODE. If your student is distance-learning and you would like them to participate in these tests, please contact your school.

If you would not like your student to participate in the required tests this year you may fill out the Opt-Out forms (English & Spanish) and return them to your student's school. There is not an opt-out form for science, however, you have the right to decline your student's participation in this test for religious or disability reasons. A request may be written and turned in with your opt-out forms.
