

PHES: K-5 Updates

New guidance from the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) was released on Friday, April 2nd. There have been a few updates to the Ready School Safe Learner Guidance. Teachers are now able to take their students outside for a stationary "mask break," allowing students to temporarily remove their masks for a designated period of time. As long as students are still socially distanced (6ft apart), and staying in their designated space, they may participate in the "mask break."
